In accordance with the Memo No. HPH/ 9M -05/2019/ 190 dated 16.07.2021, Viral Hepatitis Screening of inmates of Correctional Home has been introduced. For scaling it up to correctional homes in districts (number of inmates not exceeding 800), HBsAg and HCV serological RDT Kits are to be used for screening at site. The Dy CMOH II will organise saturation screening within a month for all inmates.


