Sub: TI intervention in Darjeeling

Targeted Interventions (TI) for key and bridge populations has been the core prevention strategy under NACP in India. Viral Hepatitis Program will cover the said populations for interventions on Hepatitis B & C in a collaborative mode.

Aim of intervention in HRGs:-

No HBV / HCV case should be missed from TI, with or without HIV – co infection. Every opportunity should be used to communicate HBV / HCV risk to HRGs and motivate them for screening.

Approach: - NGO/CBO led peer outreach model.

Role of the District: District will coordinate with TIs for prevention / management of Hepatitis Band C in the package of prevention services for the key and bridge populations.

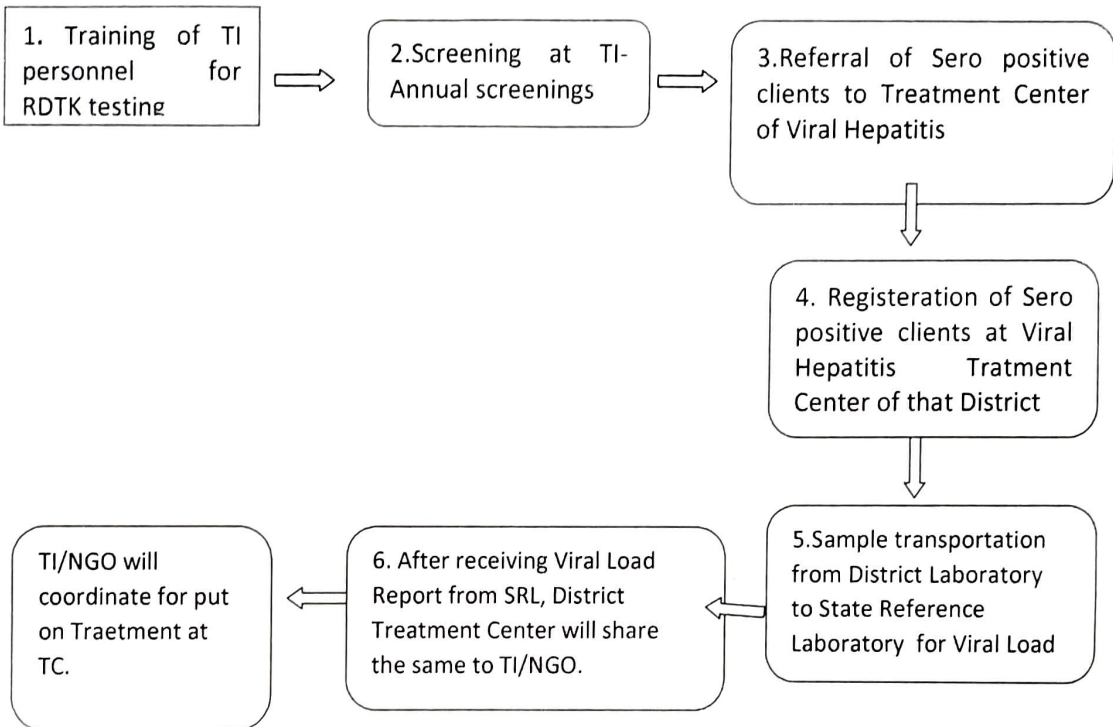
