Human surveillance for Avian Flu on 06-02-2008

(Based on reports on 5.2.08)

A. Avian influenza outbreak: Situation update

- On date, 48 blocks and five municipalities of 14 (Birbhum, Dakshin Dinajpur, Murshidabad, Burdwan, Nadia, Malda, Coochbihar, Bankura, Hooghly, Purulia, Hooghly, Paschim Medinipur, North 24 Parganas and South 24 Parganas) districts are affected.
- Small area of Uttar Dinajpur district adjoining to affected area of Chanchal, Malda and Small area of Purba Medinipur adjoining Debra, Paschim Medinipur have been under surveillance.
- No new area has been notified today.

B. Preventing human infection:

Community surveillance on 05-02-2008:

- Population surveyed : 32.83 Lakh people.
- Fever cases found : 4905 (0.15%)
- Dakshin Dinajpur and Bankura are doing passive surveillance.
- Suspected case of human Avian Influenza found : NIL

Test Reports of Biological samples :

- Biological samples tested till date : 27 (Dakshin Dinajpur: 07, Murshidabad: 02, Birbhum: 08, South 24 Parganas: 05, Purba Medinipur: 01 and North 24 Parganas: 04).
- Report of 4 samples collected (3 from South 24 Parganas and 1 from North 24 Parganas) is yet to come.
- All other samples tested negativem for Influenza AH5N1.

Rapid Response Teams (RRT) deployment

- Central and State Rapid Response Teams are engaged in surveillance activities at all the districts.
- Senior State health officers and faculty members of the medical colleges are working at districts.
- Faculty members of the medical colleges are working at selected districts.

Medical examination of health staff deployed in the field

- On date, medical teams examined a total of 6838 health personnel deployed in the fields.
- Districts have adequate stock of Tamiflu, PPE, N95 Masks, three layered masks, gloves, caps and aprons for the use of health workers engaged in community surveillance and examination of ARD staff.

Institutional preparation for management of human cases, if any

- Isolation/observation wards have been set up and equipped at all identified facilities of the affected districts.
- Till date, 15 patients under investigation have been admitted in those facilities, out of which 10 have already been discharged.
- Till date, 23 ventilators have already been installed at those facilities; 03 are under process of being installed. A total of 14 pulse-oxymeters have already been installed; rest 10 are in the process of being installed.
- All districts have identified and equipped health facilities where isolation wards can be opened if necessary and made necessary human resource planning.
- IDBG hospital, Kolkata has been identified and equipped as apex referral hospital.
- All medical colleges have formed medical teams.
- Daily coordination meetings are being held at the state and district headquarters.

C. Supporting ARD Department

- On date, a total of 6205 cullers comprising 233 teams (75 engaged in culling, and 91 in surveillance/mopping and 67 in disinfection) have been medically examined.
- They were given chemoprophylaxis (Tamiflu).

D. Disseminating information and messages to the community

- Interpersonal communication with the community by health personnel during survey.
- Distribution of 15 lakh leaflets and 1.75 lakh posters in the affected districts.
- Support received from UNICEF.
- 2000 cassettes containing audio messages have been sent to the districts. Local health authorities are playing those cassettes at important sites.
- Local cable channels are showing TV clippings and short film on Avian influenza.
- GOI and GOWB are disseminating messages on Bird Flu through Doordarshan and other major TV channels and also through All India Radio and FM band.
- Department has taken the initiative to print IEC materials in Santhali and Gorkhali languages for distribution among the aforesaid communities in different districts.
- Department has taken the initiative to print handbill on good practices and treatment seeking messages.
- All the IEC materials, guidelines, forms and protocols and important documents related to Avian Influenza have been made available to the community at the website: www.wbhealth.gov.in.
