MATERIALS FOR PRESS NOTE ON 10.02.08**(Based on reports on 09.02.08)****A. Avian influenza outbreak: Situation update**

1. No new Notification today.
2. Affected area as on 09-02-2008 : 48 blocks and five municipalities.
3. Name of the districts having notified Blocks/ Municipalities : Birbhum, Dakshin Dinajpur, Murshidabad, Burdwan, Nadia, Malda, Coochbihar, Bankura, Hooghly, Purulia, Hooghly, Paschim Medinipur, North 24 Parganas and South 24 Parganas districts are affected.
4. Districts having areas of surveillance as being adjacent to affected blocks of other districts : 02 (Uttar Dinajpur and Paschim Medinipur).

B. Preventing human infection:**Community surveillance on 09.02.08:**

1. Population surveyed: 22.9 lakh people
2. Fever cases found: 7899 cases (0.34%)
3. Dakshin Dinajpur, Burdwan and Bankura are doing passive surveillance.
4. Suspected case of human Avian Influenza found: Nil

Test reports of biological samples:

1. Biological samples tested till date: 30 (Dakshin Dinajpur: 07, Murshidabad: 02, Birbhum: 08, South 24 Parganas: 07, Purba Medinipur: 01, North 24 Parganas: 04 and Howrah: 01).
2. Reports of two samples collected from Howrah and South 24 Parganas are yet to come.
3. All other samples tested negative for Influenza A H5N1.

Rapid Response Teams (RRT) deployment

1. Central Rapid Response Teams are engaged in surveillance activities at all affected districts.
2. Senior State health officers are supervising at all affected districts
3. Faculty members of the medical colleges are working at selected districts.

Medical examination of health staff deployed in the field

1. On date, medical teams examined 4502 health personnel deployed in the fields.
2. Districts have adequate stock of Tamiflu, PPE, N95 masks, three layered masks, gloves, caps and aprons for the use of health workers engaged in community surveillance and examination of ARD staff.

Institutional preparedness for management of human cases, if any

1. Isolation/observation wards have been set up and equipped at all identified facilities of the affected districts.
2. Till date, 17 patients under investigation have been admitted in those facilities, out of which 14 have already been discharged.
3. Till date, 23 ventilators have already been installed at those facilities. A total of 14 pulse-oxymeters have already been installed; rest 10 are in the process of being installed.

4. All districts have identified and equipped health facilities where isolation wards can be opened if necessary, and made necessary human resource planning.
5. IDBG hospital, Kolkata has been identified and equipped as apex referral hospital.
6. All medical colleges have formed medical teams.
7. Daily coordination meetings are being held at the state and district headquarters.

C. Supporting ARD Department

1. On date, a total of 3639 cullers comprising 334 teams (128 engaged in culling, 113 in surveillance/mopping and 93 in disinfection) have been medically examined.
2. They were given chemoprophylaxis (Tamiflu).

D. Disseminating information and messages to the community

1. Interpersonal communication with the community by health personnel during survey.
2. Distribution of 15 lakh leaflets and 1.75 lakh posters in the affected districts.
3. Support received from UNICEF.
4. 2000 cassettes containing audio messages have been sent to the districts. Local health authorities are playing those cassettes at important sites.
5. Local cable channels are showing TV clippings and short film on Avian influenza.
6. GOI and GOWB are disseminating messages on Bird Flu through Doordarshan and other major TV channels and also through All India Radio and FM band.
7. Department has printed IEC materials in Santhali and distributed the same to selected affected districts. IEC materials in Gorkhali languages for distribution in Darjeeling have been prepared.
8. Department has printed handbill on good practices and treatment seeking messages and distributed to affected districts.
9. Department has given public messages on the ban of sale and purchase of poultry and its movement in leading Bengali and English dailies.
10. All the IEC materials, guidelines, forms and protocols and important documents related to Avian Influenza have been made available to the community at the website: www.wbhealth.gov.in.
