


Sub: Advisory on Case Management for COVID – 19 Patients

The experts from the Protocol Management Team as deputed by the Department of Health and Family Welfare, Government of West Bengal visited some COVID hospitals today and noted certain deficiencies which need urgent attention. On the basis of their observations following recommendations are made :

1. Quick Response Team should be established to ensure prompt action if patients show signs of deterioration.
2. HFNC should be available.
3. ECG, ABG should be mandatory on admission and reports to be attached with BHT.
4. Top sheet should be maintained properly.
5. Steroid and anticoagulant therapy should be practised as per protocol.
6. Ventilation strategy and guidelines should be posted prominently in the work station so that it can be followed without hesitancy.
7. Proper Donning and Doffing to be taken care of more aggressively and precisely as per protocol.

If these recommendations are implemented patient outcome is expected to improve..In subsequent visits particular note will be taken to check if these are being practised.


