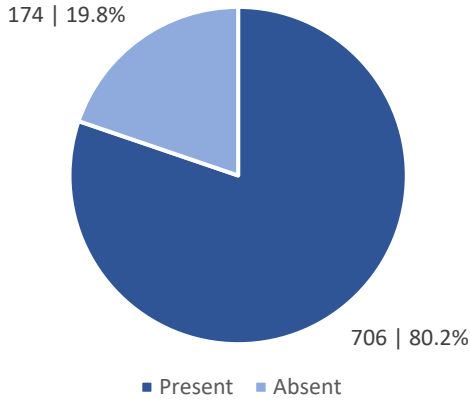

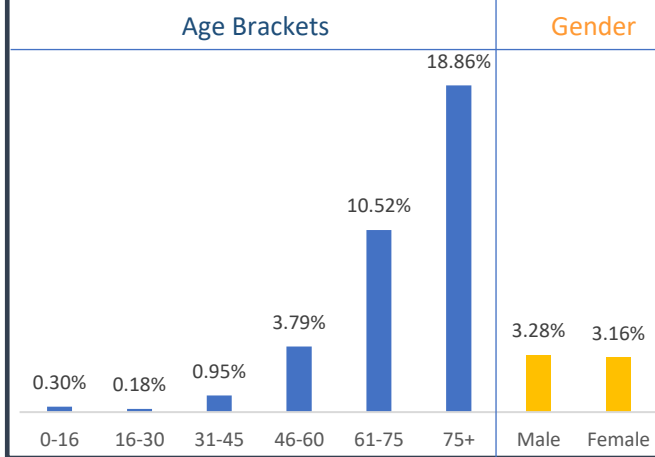

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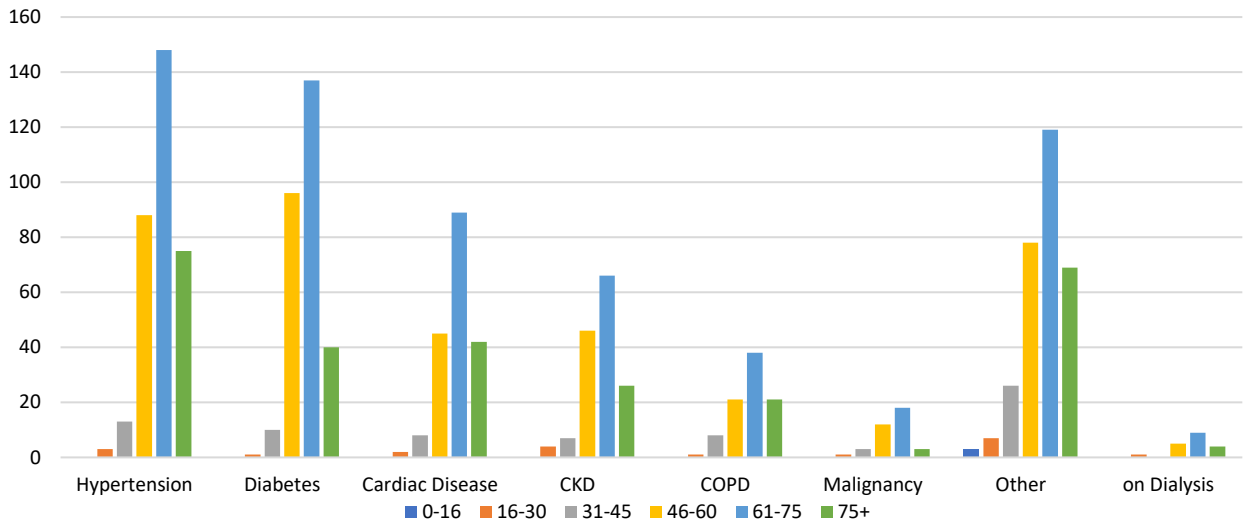
**Comorbidity Status in Deceased Cases (n=880)**



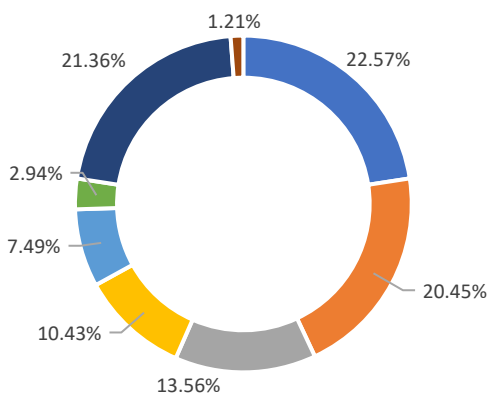
**Fatality Rate in Respective Age Brackets & Gender Group**



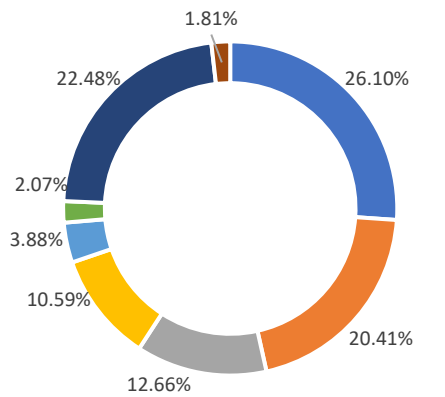
**Age Group Wise Comorbidities Among Deceased**
