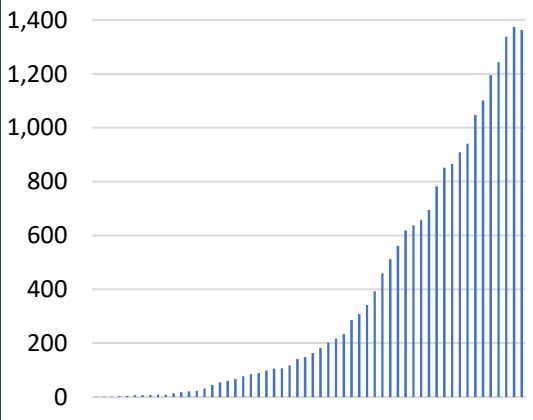

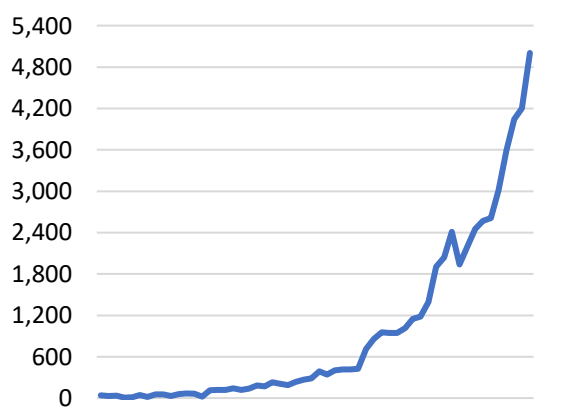
DAILY CUMULATIVE ACTIVE COVID-19 CASES
