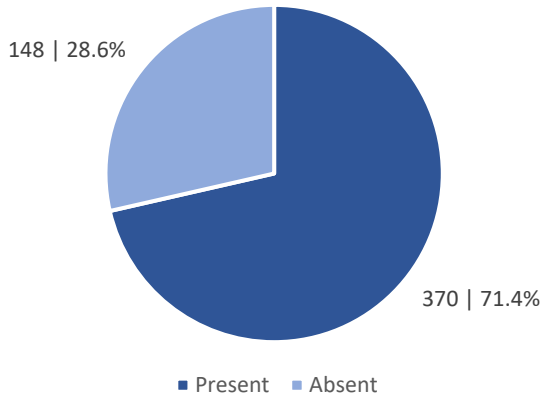

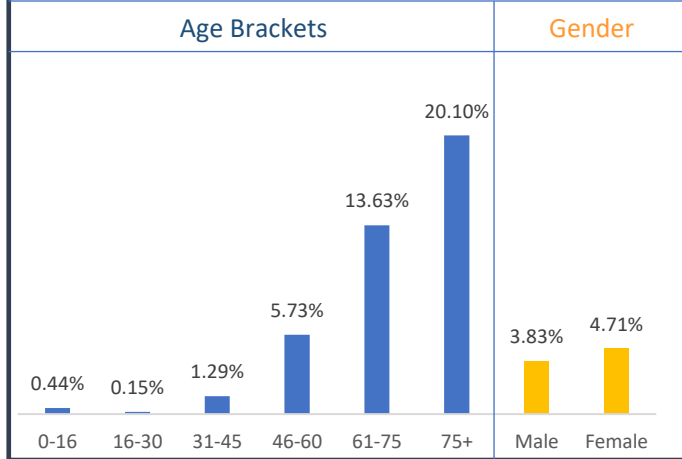

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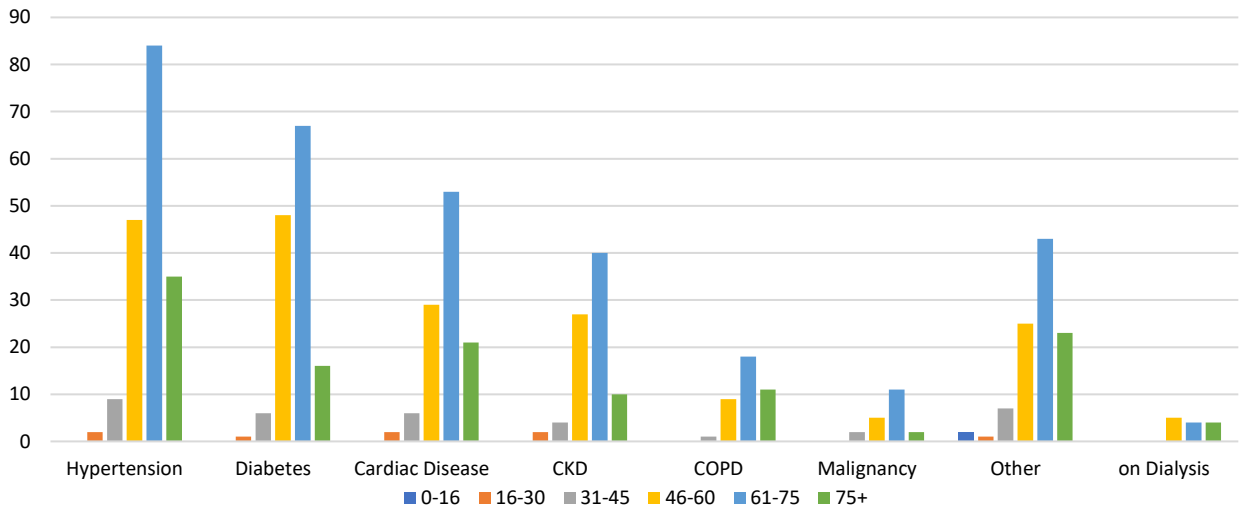
**Comorbidity Status in Deceased Cases (n=518)**



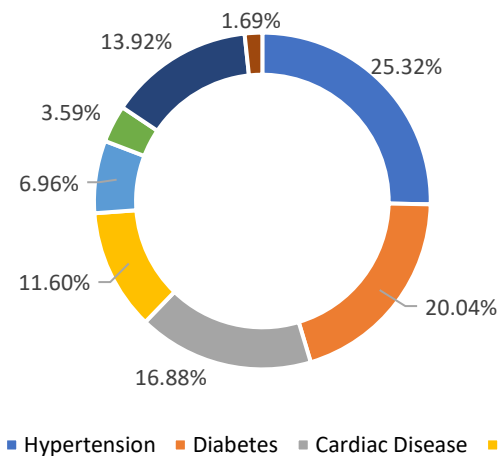
**Fatality Rate in Respective Age Brackets & Gender Group**



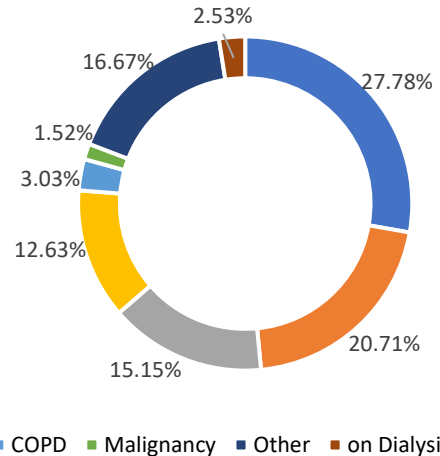
**Age Group Wise Comorbidities Among Deceased**

- Treatment is free for all patients in all Government Hospitals
- Govt has requisitioned private hospitals as COVID hospitals
- Govt reimburses these hospitals at already notified rates
- Govt has instituted a Cabinet Committee for better management of the COVID-19 crisis, chaired by Dr. Amit Mitra, and co-chaired by Shri Partha Chatterjee
- Govt has notified Medical College and Hospital, Kolkata as a full-fledged tertiary level COVID Hospital
- Govt has also notified KPC Medical College & Hospital, Kolkata as the 69<sup>th</sup> dedicated COVID Hospital in the state for specialized COVID treatment
