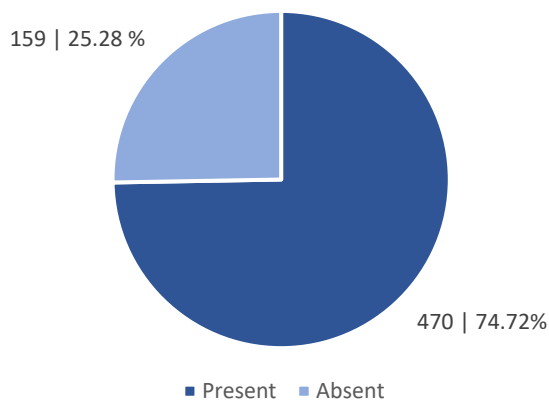

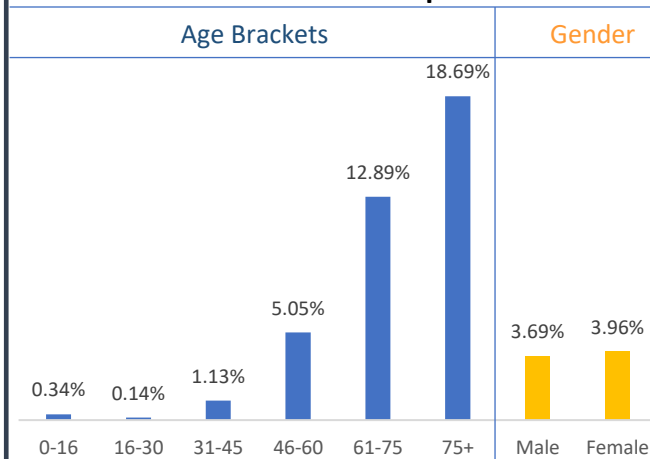
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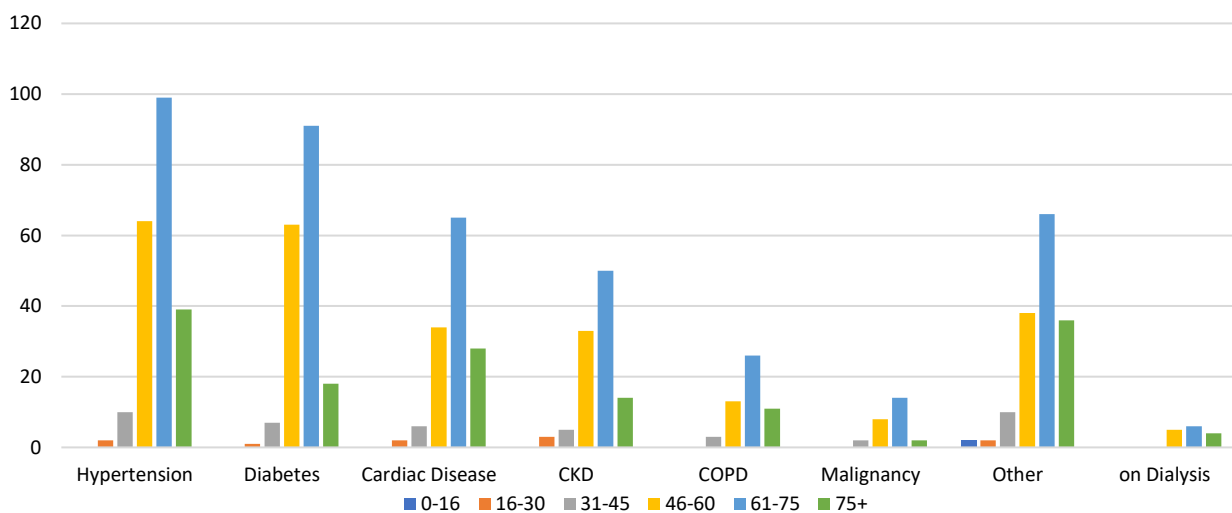
Comorbidity Status in Deceased Cases (n=629)



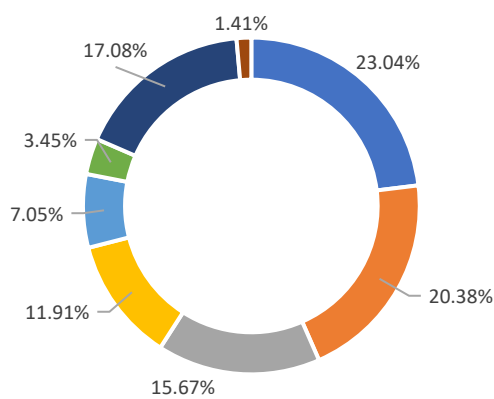
Fatality Rate in Respective Age Brackets & Gender Group



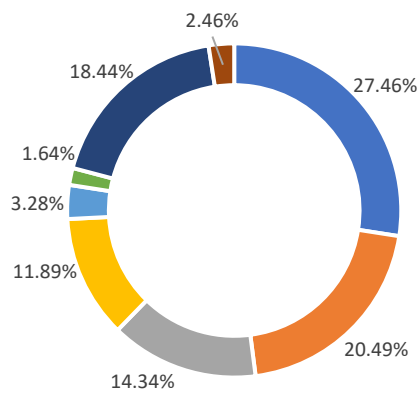
Age Group Wise Comorbidities Among Deceased
