ORDER

It appears that a good number of Community Health Officers (CHO) are eligible to undergo higher studies (Post Basic B.Sc.(Ng)/M.Sc.(Ng)/Other Higher Studies) with TR as per existing rules.

Now, the following rules will be applicable to these Staff Nurse; Gr.-II who are working as Community Health Officer.

1. The CHOs who are eligible for TR and have completed 3 years of service as regular cadre CHO will be provided NOC by the appointing authority for undergoing higher study. The operational SC-SK will be declared as vacant and necessary replacement will be taken as soon as possible.

2. The CHOs who are eligible for TR and have not completed three years of service as CHO will have to pay the bond penalty of requisite amount as per agreement after which NOC will be provided by the appointing authority for undergoing higher study.

3. In both the above case, the nursing personnel will be posted at a health facility/hospital for ensuring their salary before going to higher study.

4. After successful completion of the Post Basic BSc(Ng)/ MSc(Ng)/Other higher study(as the case may be) they will join at the place from where they are going for higher study. They may be considered for posting as CHO in existing vacancy at that instant time if they opt for posting as CHO.

All concerned are being informed accordingly.


