NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the power conferred by section 59 of the West Bengal Clinical Establishment (Registration, Regulation and Transparency) Act, 2017 (West Ben. Act IV of 2017), the Governor is pleased hereby to make, with immediate effect, the following amendments in the West Bengal Clinical Establishment (Registration, Regulation and Transparency) Rules, 2017 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules):-

Amendments

In the said Rules, in SCHEDULE II, -

(1) in clause 2, for sub-clause 2.5, *substitute* the following sub-clause:-

“2.5. There shall be at least one (1) doctor to act as Residential Medical Officer (RMO) in case of Nursing Home or Maternity Home available on duty round the clock for upto 15 beds. Thereafter, for every additional 15 beds or fraction thereof, there shall be one (1) additional RMO upto 100 beds. For every additional 20 beds or fraction thereof, there shall be further one (1) additional RMO up to 101 to 200 beds. For every additional 25 beds or fraction thereof, there shall be further one (1) additional RMO up to 201 to 300 beds. For 300 beds onward, one (1) additional RMO for every additional 50 beds or fraction thereof and so on. To ensure, such availability, the Clinical Establishments shall engage adequate number of reserve staff also.

Illustration:-

Upto 15 beds = 1 RMO;

16 to 100 beds = in addition, 1 RMO @ 15 beds (i.e. 100 beds will have 7 RMOs);

101 to 200 beds = in addition, 1 RMO @ 20 beds (i.e. 200 beds will have 12 RMOs);

201 to 300 beds = in addition, 1 RMO @ 25 beds (i.e. 300 beds will have 16 RMOs);

301 to 500 beds = in addition, 1 RMO @ 50 beds (i.e. 500 beds will have 20 RMOs);

and so on”; and

(2) in clause 3, for sub-clause 3.1, *Substitute* the following sub-clause:-

“3.1. There shall be at least four (4) qualified registered Nursing staff in case of a Nursing Home or Maternity Home upto 15 beds. Thereafter, for every additional 5 beds or fraction thereof, one (1) additional Nursing Staff shall be engaged. To ensure such availability, the Clinical Establishments shall engage adequate number of reserve staff also.

Illustration:-

upto 15 beds = 4 Nursing staff

16 – 20 beds = 5 Nursing staff

21 – 25 beds = 6 Nursing staff

26 - 30 beds = 7 Nursing staff

31 - 35 beds = 8 Nursing staff and so on.”

This order is issued with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide U.O. No. Group O/2021-2022/0040 dated 13/08/2021, and also with approval of the State Cabinet, vide Cabinet Secretariat U.O. No. CAB(D)-76 dated 06/09/2021.

This notification shall have immediate effect.
