ORDER


The undersigned is directed by the order of the Governor to say that the Course Fees of post graduate students of DNB (Diplomate of National Board) admitted in state running Institutions, to be deposited at the time of admission and per annum, keeping the Tuition fees, Library fees, Annual appraisal fees and Hostel accommodation charges are as per Revised Fees guidelines of NBEMS dated 03.04.2019 and thus the Annual Course Fees will be Rs.1,25,000/- in aggregate per student excluding GST.

2. Admission and tuition fees of Rs. 75000/- per annum per student will, however, be deposited into Government exchequer via Treasury to the Head of A/C. " 0210-Medical and Public Health-04-Public Health-104-Fees,Fines etc.-001-Receipts from Other Fees, Fines etc,-27-Other Receipt" [CODE: 0210-04-104-001-27].

3. The undersigned is further directed to say that this department will allow the hospital authorities to retain the Library fees, Annual appraisal fees and Hostel accommodation charges and to deposit in the Bank account of Rogi Kalyan Samity (RKS) of the concerned District Hospital. Since the students taking admission in Post graduate equivalent DNB courses will be able to pursue it in all the hospitals running DNB Courses where library facility and accommodation for PG students may not be available at Government cost, Rogi Kalyan Samity will be responsible for-

- i) subscribing out of library fund, to be created with Library fees, for books, journals, research paper which will be required by the students and for making these materials available to the students;
 - ii) providing accommodation for the students on rental basis out of the accommodation charges to be collected from DNB students, if Government accommodation/ hostel facility is not made available, without any additional financial implications vesting on the Government; and
 - iii) payment of annual appraisal fees to the authority out of the money realized for the purpose from the DNB students, without any additional financial implications vesting on the Government. In special cases, payment of appraisal related fees may be done in advance in response to the NBEMS notification from time to time mentioning the proper adjustment of fund from their end.
4. This order issued with the concurrence of the Finance Department (Group T) vide U O No: Group T/2022-2023/0857 dated 11/10/2022.
5. This order will come into effect for 2019-20 sessions onwards.


