Sub: **Authorizing Homoeopathic Practitioners to issue Medical certificate under Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 Section 8 sub-section (3).**

Madam/Sir,


It has come to the notice that AYUSH Practitioner are considered unauthorized to provide Medical/Fitness Certificate by organizations like ESI, Transport Department etc. This matter is seen as violation of the statutory right as provided under Sub-Section (c) of Section 34(1) of National Commission for Homoeopathy Act of 2020. i.e. be entitled to sign or authenticate a medical or fitness certificate or any other certificate required by any law to be signed or authenticated by a duly qualified medical practitioner, who is enrolled in the State Register or the National Register.

The expression by any law to be signed means that this provision shall apply to and override any such law passed by either State or Central Legislative which requires a duly qualified medical practitioner to issue, sign or authenticate medical certificate. In another words the Act States that a term "duly qualified medical practitioner" shall also encapsulate the authorized practitioners of Homoeopathic System of Medicine, registered under State and National Register.

The National Commission for Homoeopathy is a complete code in itself and extends to the whole of India. Therefore, being a complete code in itself it deals with the regulation of practitioners of Homoeopathy as defined Under 2 (h) of the NCH Act, 2020.

In view of the above, Concerned Authorities are directed to take necessary action and consider the Medical/Fitness Certificate issued by the AYUSH Practitioners with credibility.
