**Sub:- Release of original documents of Dr. Sweta Gupta.**

In pursuance of 'Court Order' passed by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta in connection with W.P.A. 186(W) of 2019, Dr Sweta Gupta is a **citizen of 'Nepal'** was admitted for undergoing MS (G&O) course during the session 2019-22 at IPGMER, Kolkata. The WBUHS allowed her admission for the said course. The MCI allotted medical registration to Dr Gupta to enable her to pursue the course. Dr Gupta obtain MS (G&O) degree from WBUHS. The temporary registration given to Dr Gupta by the MCI, **expired** on 01/07/2022. Although Dr Gupta expressed her willingness to continue bond service, the MCI **refused** to allot further registration to Dr Gupta as she is a citizen of 'Nepal'.

The matter has been reviewed by the 'higher authority' in light of the existing rules and present situation. Considering the facts and circumstances, **Dr Sweta Gupta**, the citizen of 'Nepal' is hereby **exempted** from compulsory bond service and the Director, I.P.G.M.E. & R, Kolkata is also directed to **release** the original documents of Dr Gupta from his office at an early date. All concerned are informed accordingly.
