MEMORANDUM

One meeting was held along with the Executive committee members on 05.01.2023 as per memo no HFW-37099/111/2022/1676 Dated- 28.12.2022. After discussion with all members the following criteria has been formulated for selection of candidates for PhD in Nursing.

1. Submission of application will be within 31st January (1st phase) for WBUHS & 31st August (2nd phase) for AIIMS and INC approved University in each year.
2. The Institution/University will be UGC approved and INC affiliated University. Preferences will be given for WBUHS, West Bengal.
3. Proposal for the PhD should be NURSING related.
4. All eligible candidates can apply for NOC to appear in examination. After RAT clearance the candidates will be selected through **SYNOPSIS** evaluation by the committee members.
5. Yearly 15 (fifteen) candidates only may be allow to get NOC for undergo PhD in Nursing programme .

For the 1st phase 9 candidates (3- CON,3-NTS & 3 from Nursing service)

For the 2nd phase 6 candidates (2- CON,2-NTS & 2 from Nursing service)

6. The candidates who will apply in the current year for PhD in Nursing , the NOC will be issued for that candidates only.
7. Having 3 years teaching/Clinical/Community experiences after passing M.Sc. Nursing (3 yrs to be counted from the date of publication of result to the last day of application).
8. Obtain at least 60% marks in M.Sc. (Nsg)
9. Have at least one publication in a journal before application for PhD in Nursing.
10. Data collection during the duty hours will not be allowed.
11. No TR/ Scholarship /Promotion/ Financial benefit will be granted for this.
12. The committee will decide the eligible candidates as per meeting resolution.
