### Training order

State Government has planned to protect the children by augmenting in-patient Covid facilities both in form of general as well as critical care beds for the younger age group. This includes augmentation of facilities for Pediatric Dialysis in selected institutions. At present about 31 dedicated Covid Dialysis Units are functional and some new units are under process. To make the existing set up effective to deal with Pediatric Dialysis cases, a comprehensive training program will be conducted on Pediatric Dialysis Management with special emphasis on Covid situation.

In accordance to Govt Order HFW-14015(17)/23/2021-SPSRC SEC-Dept. of H&FW/PPP/1518 Dated 26/07/2021 1st Pediatric COVID Dialysis Training workshop was conducted successfully from 02.08.2021 to 07.08.2021, at three venues, SSKM, NRSMCH and Kolkata MCH.

In continuation with the same objective the 2<sup>nd</sup> Pediatric Peritoneal Dialysis training workshop will be held at North Bengal MCH.

The details of the training program will be as follows:-

- 1. The Training will be conducted from 03.09.2021 to 04.09.2021, at NBMCH, Darjeeling.
- 2. It will be an offline (physical)training program, where Medical Officer, Residents, Pediatricians and MT Dialysis will be oriented by expert panel of Pediatric Nephrology, though classroom lectures and practical Hands-on classes.
- Due to current pandemic situation maximum 20-25 participants will be trained physically over 2 days targeting mainly Post Graduate Trainees, Medical officers and Pediatricians and Physicians working in PICU, NICU, SNCU, ICUs of the North Bengal Region and Departmental/ PPP MT Dialysis.
- 4. The schedule of the Training program is attached in Annexure –I, and the list of MT Dialysis who will attend the training program, physically in batch A is attached in Annexure II.
- 5. Concerned MSVP, CMOH and Superintendent COVID and non COVID are requested to release the MT Dialysis to attend training program as per Annexure-II.
- 6. The Refreshment and logistics for the training program will be arranged by NBMCH acting as training centre and payment for same will be made from COVID funds. Principal and MSVP NBMCH may be requested for the same. If the Trainees have any requirement for night stay including fooding, the same will be arranged by NBMCH and payment done as per Govt guidelines from COVID funds.
