Training order

State Government has planned to protect the children by augmenting in-patient Covid facilities both in form of general as well as critical care beds for the younger age group. This includes augmentation of facilities for Pediatric Dialysis in selected institutions. At present about 31 dedicated Covid Dialysis Units are functional and some new units are under process. To make the existing set up effective to deal with Pediatric Dialysis cases, a comprehensive training program will be conducted on Pediatric Dialysis Management with special emphasis on Covid situation.

In accordance to Govt Order HFW-14015(17)/23/2021-SPSRC SEC-Dept. of H&FW/PPP/1518 Dated 26/07/2021 and HFW-14015(17)/23/2021-SPSRC SEC-Dept. of H&FW/PPP/1535 Dated 25/08/2021 Training and workshop was conducted successfully at Kolkata (SSKM/NRSMCH/Kolkata MCH) and NBMCH.

In continuation with the same objective the 3rd Pediatric Dialysis training workshop including Peritoneal Dialysis will be held at BSMCH, Bankura.

The details of the training program will be as follows:-

1. The Training will be conducted from 09.11.2021 to 10.11.2021, at BSMCH (Bankura).
2. Prof Dr, Arpita Roy Choudhury Dept of Nephrology IPGMER SSKM and Dr. Niladri Bose, Dept. of Pediatrics Nephrology ICH, Kolkata MCH and Dr. Sumantra Kumar Raut, Assistant Prof. Dept. of Nephrology, BSMCH will be visiting experts.
3. It will be an offline (physical) training program, where Medical Officer, Residents, Pediatricians and MT Dialysis will be oriented by expert panel of Pediatric Nephrology, through classroom lectures and practical Hands-on classes.
4. Due to current pandemic situation maximum 20-25 participants will be trained physically over 2 days targeting mainly Post Graduate Trainees, Medical officers and Pediatricians and Physicians working in PICU, NICU, SNCU, ICUs of the BSMCH Region and Departmental/ PPP MT Dialysis.
5. The schedule of the Training program is attached in Annexure -I, and the list of MT Dialysis who will attend the training program, physically in batch A is attached in Annexure II.
6. Concerned MSVP, CMOH and Superintendent COVID and non COVID are requested to release the MT Dialysis to attend training program as per Annexure-II.
7. The Refreshment and logistics for the training program will be arranged by BSMCH acting as training centre and payment for same will be made from COVID funds. Principal and MSVP BSMCH may be requested for the same. If the Trainees have any requirement for

night stay including fooding, the same will be arranged by BSMCH and payment done as per Govt guidelines from COVID funds.




