**Advertisement for Admission into Diploma in Pharmacy Course
for the Academic Year 2022-2023.**

Online applications are invited from eligible candidates, desiring for admission into two years Diploma Course in Pharmacy in the three Govt. Pharmacy Institutes (Institute of Pharmacy, Kalyani, Institute of Pharmacy, Bankura and Institute of Pharmacy, Jalpaiguri) for the year 2022-2023.

Eligibility criteria:

- 1. Minimum educational qualification and other criteria, required for the admission:**
 - (A) Pass in the Higher Secondary (10+2) examination in science stream or equivalent examination as recognized by the Pharmacy Council of India.**
 - (B) Students passed in H.S (10+2) examination or equivalent in Vocational Stream/Distance education course are not eligible for the application in the above mentioned course.**
- 2. Age limit:** Minimum 17 years and not more than 30 years as on 1st June, 2022 and not more than 35 years for candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe as on 1st June, 2022.
- 3. Candidates should be Indian Citizens** and either has been residing in the State of West Bengal uninterruptedly/continuously for not less than 10 years as on 31.12.2021 or who or whose parents are permanent residents of West Bengal and have their permanent addresses in West Bengal.
- 4. Candidates must submit the required application fees through online for consideration of their application and fees must be submitted in the head of the account as given below:**

Fees:-

a) Rs. 500/- (Five hundred) only for unreserved candidates

and

b) Rs 200/- (Two hundred) only for SC/ST/OBC/PH

c) The fees to be deposited online (credit card/debit card/net banking) in favour of "The West Bengal State Health & Family Welfare Samiti" in the account of Punjab National Bank (PNB), Salt Lake-Sector-V Branch, A/C No. 1432010100410, IFSC: PUNB0143220, MICR: 700027238 in the Head of Account-Medical Education, W.B.

The online banking charges as applicable is to be borne by the candidate which is extra. The application is one time procedure & fees remitted is non-refundable.

Selection Procedures:

- 1. Candidates will be selected on the basis of total marks** obtained in Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics or Biology (whichever is higher) at the H.S (10+2) Examination (General Stream) or equivalent examination as approved by the Pharmacy Council of India. **Candidates have to separately pass both the theory and practical examination in physics, chemistry, and biology (if biology is considered for merit list).** The tie shall be broken up by marks in Chemistry if still tie, then Physics and if still tie, then Mathematics or Biology (whichever is higher) & if still a tie then higher age would incur higher merit position.

Upgradation: This year upgradation will be available. During form fill up upgradation option will be there. A candidate may select or may not select upgradation at that stage. However, further during admission 1st and 2nd round there will be provision of upgradation for the allotted candidates at the allotted college during admission. Except for the candidate allotted for the highest preferred choice. The upgradation sought or not opted by the allotted candidate at the college level shall supersede the earlier upgradation response provided by the candidate during form fill up.

2. Reservations:

Seats will be reserved for candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and other Backward Classes (Non-Creamy Layer) and also for Physically Handicapped Candidates as per existing rules of Government of West Bengal. Admission of the PH candidates is subject to verification and approval by the Medical Board-at SSKM Medical College & Hospital, Kolkata-20 **(verification of PH Candidates at the Medical Board-SSKM Medical College and Hospital, A.J. C Bose Road, Kolkata-20, on 02.08.2022, 03.08.2022, 04.08.2022 and 05.08.2022 from 10.30 am to 2 pm and it has been already Notified vide Memo No. HPT/IP-04-10/Pt-VII/M/1710, Dated 20.07.2022).**

Candidate should carry the original and self attested photocopy of the caste/physically handicapped certificates, issued by the Competent Authority.

- 3. Four candidates nominated by the G.T.A., Darjeeling will be admitted in the Institute of Pharmacy, Jalpaiguri** subject to the approval of Department of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of West Bengal **(Date of Reporting and Admission at Institute of Pharmacy, Jalpaiguri 12.09.2022 and 13.09.2022 from 11 am to 4 pm).**

One hardcopy of the online application along with receipt of the application fees along with original certificates and documents in appropriate format during 1st round admission in the allotted college on 12.09.2022 and 13.09.2022 (Time: 11 am to 4 pm).

5.A. Candidates have to produce the domicile certificate issued by the Appropriate Authority (viz. viz. District Magistrate/Additional District Magistrate/Deputy Magistrate/Deputy Collector/Sub-divisional Officer/Block Development Officer/ Superintendent of Police/Additional Superintendent of Police/Sub-divisional Police Officer/Deputy Superintendent of Police/Commissioner/Additional Commissioner/Joint Commissioner/Deputy Commissioner/Assistant Commissioner of Police Commissionerate/Judicial Magistrate of any Rank or position in the concerned district or Metropolitan Locality or Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta or Hon'ble Supreme Court of India/Corporation area-Commissioner, Additional Commissioner, Joint Commissioner, assistant Commissioner/Assistant Secretary or above in the Secretariat of the Govt. of West Bengal (including GTA) or Central Government/ Deputy Director or above in the Directorate to the Govt. of West Bengal or Central Government)/head of the institution from which the candidate has passed in 10+2 examination in the year 2022 as per existing rules/norms of Government of West Bengal, in original as per format available in the same website *vide*. Proforma-a1, a2 & b (as applicable), at the time of 1st round admission and original documents verification in the allotted college on 12.09.2022 and 13.09.2022 (Time: 11 am to 4 pm) **[Candidate gets the proforma a1, a2 & b from the previous Notification vide Memo No. HPT/IP-04-10/Pt-VII/M/1710, Dated 20.07.2022].**

They must also produce supporting documents (Aadhar card/Voter Card/Passport (any one) showing residence in W.B, in original and self attested photocopy of the same.

The admitted candidates must deposit the original H.S (10+2) Mark sheet and Certificate or equivalent examination certificate to the respective college authority against a receipt issued by the college authority. The receipt has to be kept secured by the candidate as after completion of course/if candidate resigns from the course/if candidates gets upgraded in subsequent round of counseling, then candidate can get back originals by the deposition of receipt.

5.(A)-(i) Officials issuing domicile certificate must provide his/her FULL NAME, DESIGNATION, PLACE OF POSTING WITH ADDRESS, LAND LINE/ MOBILE NUMBER. He/she should also provide his/her IDENTITY CARD NUMBER if available.

5.(A)-(ii) CERTIFICATE FROM ANY AUTHORITY OTHER THAN THOSE LISTED ABOVE “WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED”.

5.(A)-(iii) Note: Domicile certificate issued by any elected people's Representative such as Municipal Commissioner, Councillor of Municipal Corporation/ Municipality, Member of Three tiers Panchayat System or GTA, MLA or MP are not acceptable.

5.(A)-(iv) **Proforma a2** must be signed and certified by the head of the institution from which the candidate has passed in 10+2 examination in the year 2022. Such certificate must be issued after verification of the school education record of the candidates.

Criteria to be treated as domicile and applicable proforma of certificate

Only those candidates will be treated as domicile of West Bengal, who is either,

(i) Residing in West Bengal continuously at least for last 10 (ten) years as on 31/12/2021

OR

(ii) Whose(s) parents is /are permanent resident of West Bengal having permanent address within state of West Bengal.

5.B. Candidate have to produce the original medical (Physical & Mental) fitness certificate from a Registered Medical Practitioner (West Bengal Medical Council)/Medical Officer of a Government Hospital (*MBBS* qualified) and a **certificate from a Registered Eye Specialist, certifying acuity of vision and absence of colour blindness**, in original as per format available in website-*vide*. Proforma-c & d [Candidates gets the proforma c & d from the previous Notification vide Memo No. HPT/IP-04-10/Pt-VII/M/1710, Dated 20.07.2022].

5.C. Admission of the PH candidates is subject to verification of the PH Status and approval by the Medical Board at SSKM Medical College & Hospital, A.J.C. Bose Road, Kolkata 700020 and candidate should carry the original and photocopy of the physically handicap certificates issued by the competent authority during admission in respective college. The date for the verification of the PH Status at the Medical Board, SSKM Medical College & Hospital, already notified vide Memo No. HPT/IP-04-10/Pt-VII/M/1710, Dated 20.07.2022.

5.(D)-(i) Original and two self attested photocopy of age proof (Birth Certificate/Madhyamik admit card).

5.(D)-(ii) Original and two self attested photocopies of Mark-sheet of 10+2 or equivalent examination.

5.(D)-(iii) Three stamp size and Two Passport size coloured recent photographs.

5.(D)-(iv) **Original and a self attested copy of S.C./S.T./O.B.C-A/O.B.C-B/P.H. Certificates in appropriate cases.**

For OBC-A and OBC-B candidates, they have to additionally provide non-creamy layer certificate issued from the same authority who issued the earlier OBC-A/OBC-B certificate if the OBC-A/OBC-B certificate was issued prior to/on 31.03.2021. If OBC-A/OBC-B certificate is issued on/after 01.04.2021, then such non-creamy layer certificate is not required.

5.(D)-(v) Self declaration form must be produced during admission in allotted college.

5.(D)-(vi) Candidates are not allowed to fill up more than one online application form.


Application fees and Admission fees are non-refundable.

6. The candidate has to pay the following fee at the allotted college during admission:

(a) Admission fee: Rs. 500/- (b) Tuition fee: Rs.1200/- (c) Session fee: Rs. 100/-

(d) Registration: Rs. 600/- (e) Caution Deposit: Rs. 200/-

(f) Hostel Seat Rent: Rs. 1200/- (if such facility is available at the allotted college).



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
