As per the decision taken on the Pre-Bid meeting the following changes has been finalised by the Tender Selection Committee-

1	In the NIT document, (Page no 16), under GCC point no. 21, Termination for convenience; date of termination after issuing the written notice	Notice for termination will have to be issued either contractor or the Purchaser earlier one (1) month earlier.
2	In the NIT document page no. 20, Section V, Point no. 1: Commercial BLS Ambulance should be registered by the Transport Department (Govt. of West Bengal)	Commercial BLS Ambulance may registered by any State of India but should have permit to perform in West Bengal
3	In the NIT document page no. 20, Section V, Point no. 7: Emergency Medical Technician details	Bidders have to submit the certificate of the qualified EMT. The technical qualification of EMT is attached herewith for reference. (HFW-27011/233/2021-NHM SEC-Dept. of H&FW/4001 dated 24.12.2021). EMT qualification will be read as attached instead of NIT document page no. 20, Section V, Point no. 7.
4	In the NIT page no. 20, Section V, Point no. 8: Bidder asked that the Work contract for hiring of BLS Ambulance is transferable to sub-contractor or not?	No, it will be treated as per the notice. The Contract for hiring of BLS Ambulance is non-transferable.
5	In the NIT page no. 20, Section V, Point no. 11: Bidder asked the provider of drugs and consumable use in the Ambulance	All Drugs and PPE for the patients will be borne by the authority. The agency should borne the consumable for the persons deployed by the agency. Refer e-NIT document last paragraph in page no. 29.
6	In the NIT page no. 21, Section V, Point no. 12: Bidder asked how many time given to the agency for providing extra Ambulance (if needed)	One (1) month time will be given for deployment of extra Ambulance.
7	In the NIT document page no. 21, Section V, Point no. 18: Bidder asked that if the Ambulance is hypothecated to a Bank/Financial Institute, the papers of such Ambulance need to provided to the purchaser or not	No Change of this point. The Agency has to produce concurrence of the Bank/Financial Institute for the BLS Ambulance to be engaged for Jhargram District if the Ambulance is hypothecated.
8	In the NIT document page no 14, GCC sub-clause Point no. 16.2 (a): Bidder asked that how much time taken for payment.	As mentioned in the page no. 14, point no. 16.2 (a,b & c) the bidders have to submit all the relevant documents as mentioned. After verify the bills,

		payment will be made in favour of the agency within 3 months or as per the availability of fund.
9	In the NIT document page no 31, Price Schedule/Bill of quantity	The bidder will have to submit the quoted price for Fixed charges for upto 1000 KM running per month basis only. Bidders will not require quoting rate for Sl. No (ii) Fixed charges per Kilometre for above 1000 KM running per month basis. It will be beyond 1000 KM fuel cost @ one litre Diesel for operation of eight (8) Kilometres. It will be fixed for all bidders.
